Dr. Jain completed a general surgery internship at the University of Arizona and urology residency at the University of Texas. He has an interest in all aspects of urology including oncology, robotic surgery, incontinence, stone disease and erectile dysfunction. In addition, his interest in medical research has culminated into multiple publications. Dr. Jain has also published data at UCLA in the field pediatric urology regarding a novel SRY gene mutation.
